Will there be any homework and exam/test?

There will be periodic home assignments that you will complete online. These are meant to help you evaluate your learning. Most of you will find them simple and interesting. There will also be a short, term-end evaluation that will help you obtain the much coveted certification. The course materials and guidance prepares you adequately to deal with all homework and the final evaluation.

How much time will I be required to spend on this course?

Apart from the one half day a month contact session at SIES (Sion West), you will be required to devote between 3-5 hours each week on self study. You may set your own pace for the self study and a mentor is always available to respond to your queries. The monthly contact sessions will also prove valuable in helping you understand your study matter. Spread over 6 months, this course has a gentle yet steady pace which ensures that each of you (from varied backgrounds) will have an opportunity to learn all that is on offer.

What will this course cost?

The fee for this entire course is Rs. 10,000/- per learner.

What is the Format and Duration of Course?

- This course is a distance learning course which is hosted online. Its medium of study and instruction will be English. Almost all resources required for this course will be available via the online classroom. The course has 5 half day contact classes held on the last Saturday of each month at the SIES campus, Sion.
- The duration of the entire course (including all contact sessions) is 6 months.
